Reminders

The Board has made an important change to our by-laws. The use of motorized recreational vehicles is now prohibited on Country Village common property. Our association insurance does not cover them or their use, and any damage done can be expensive for the vehicle operator to fix. The Town Police have also been made aware of these changes.

Our neighborhood trash pick-up is Wednesday. Please place your trash and recycling containers at the curb Tuesday night and move them back out of sight by Wednesday evening, or make arrangements to have someone move them in for you.

Our Association By-laws state that the Board of Directors is obligated to collect fees from each homeowner to pay association expenses. We appreciate your timely payments of the semi-annual dues. For those homeowners who have failed to keep up their payments, the Board is willing to work with you to come up with an acceptable payment plan. For owners who continue to be delinquent, we are now using a collection agency to follow up on those accounts. If collection is unsuccessful liens may be placed; we currently have placed one lien on a property. The Board is disappointed that these measures had to be taken. We did so only after a number of unsuccessful efforts to contact the owners and as a matter of fairness to the vast majority of owners who have paid their dues on time.
